WWZ – S15 (HG)

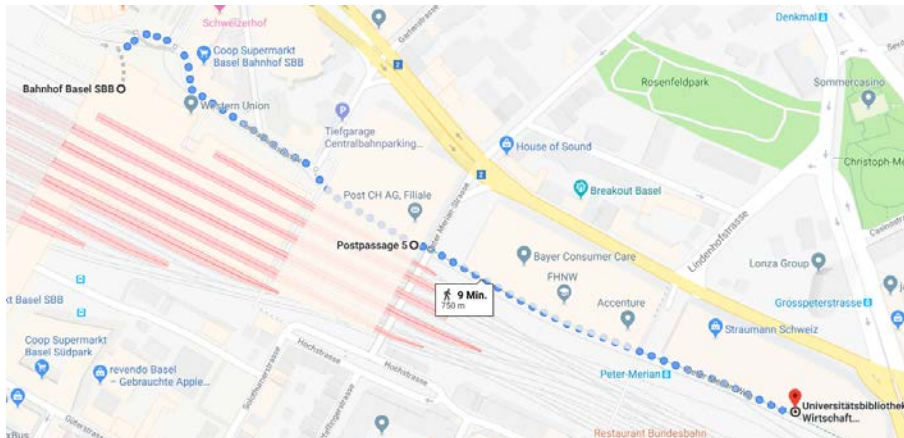
Tram:

No. 10 or 11 to “Peter Merian” (direction: Dornach Tram10, Aesch BL Tram 11, first stop)

By foot:

Instead of taking the tram, you can also easily walk from the train station to the Jacob Burckhardt-House (see map below).

The Room S15 is in the Hofgeschoss (HG), i.e. in the basement.



Villa Merian (Dinner)

Tram:

No. 10 or 11 to “Dreispietz” (direction: Dornach Tram10, Aesch BL Tram 11) or No. 10 to “Neue Welt” (direction: Dornach)

From both tram stops, you walk approximately 10 minute to Villa Merian (Nr. 8 on the map).
